INVITATION FOR BID


The Governor of Guam, Felix P. Camacho, through the Department of Public Works, is soliciting bids for the Route 17 Rehabilitation and Widening From Route 4 to Route 4A (Phase 1). Interested parties are required to submit two (2) copies and one (1) original of their sealed bids to the Division of Highways Building, Room 201, 2nd Floor, Department of Public Works Office, 542 North Marine Corps Drive Upper Tumon, Guam 96913, no later than 2:00 p.m., on **August 6, 2009**. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud shortly afterwards in the Department of Public Works Division of Highways Building, Conference Room.

Contract time is **300 calendar days** after issuance of Notice to Proceed. All bids must be accompanied by a bid security in the amount of 15% of the total bid amount. Bid security may be made by a bid bond, certified check, or cashier's check made payable to the Treasurer of Guam. Bid documents can be obtained from the Department of Public Works Division of Highways Building commencing on **May 21, 2009**. The surety companies offered must be on the approved listing by the Government of Guam or the United States Department of Treasury listed as "Companies Holding Certificates of Authority as Acceptable Sureties on Federal Bonds and Acceptable Reinsuring Companies".

All interested parties are hereby notified that minority business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to the invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color and national origin in consideration for an award.

The right is reserved to reject any or all bids and to waive any imperfection in the bids in the best interest of the Government of Guam.

A pre-bid conference will be held on **May 28, 2009** at 9:00 a.m. at the Department of Public Works, Division of Highways Building Conference Room. An investigation of the site to allow prospective bidders to familiarize themselves with said project will be conducted after the pre-bid conference. All prospective bidders are encouraged to attend. Items discussed during the pre-bid meeting will be made part of the contract document.
