Swearing-In Ceremony for Newly Formed Guam Regional Transit Authority Board



(Adelup, Guam September 25, 2009) Members of the Board of Directors for the newly formed Guam Regional Transit Authority were sworn in today by Governor Felix P. Camacho at a Ceremony held at Adelup this morning. Members include: Ben Gumataotao, Mayor of Piti; Louise Rivera, Vice Mayor of Tamuning-Tumon-Harmon; Ginger S. Porter, Guam Cedders, & Manuel Q. Cruz, Exec. Dir. of Guam Developmental Disabilities Council.



Through Public Law 30-5, introduced by Senators Tom Ada, Adolfo Palacios and Tina Muna Barnes, the Guam Regional Transit Authority was re-established to oversee the management and governance of a Guam public transit system. Prior to the passage of P.L. 30-5, the administration of the transit system was conducted by staff within the Department of Administration. As a major component of the 2030 Guam Transportation Plan, officials from the Department of Public Works, the Federal Highway Administration, the Department of Administration and the Legislative Committee on Utilities, Transportation, Public Works and Veterans Affairs chaired by Senator Tom Ada have been working collaboratively for the establishment of an integrated public transit system to meet the needs of our Guam community through 2030.
